XgContacts Importer v2.0

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Brief Introduction

Ever wonder how to import email contacts information like the name and email into your PHP or other server-side scripts with a click of a button? Well, this script does just that.

It is written in PHP and utilizes the cURL functions to retrieve the contacts directly through your server page.

Server Requirement

PHP 5.0 or above, cURL with OpenSSL Support, Apache/IIS Server Software, PHP Mail function (optional), Windows/Linux OS.

Technical Support*

Our products cover a '5' day technical support. In other words, support will be limited to 5 days after the purchase. Additional fees may be applied if support is provided after the 5 days.

POST Integration

Although written in PHP, our script has no problem sending the contacts detail to another server side script written in Coldfusion or ASP using POST action method. Your action page can be changed in config.php.

Note: Our script will POST in Array format instead of text format. Name of the array is email[].

You can use the contacts to send newsletter, to save to your address book and many more! In the archive, you will see a file named **sendmail.php**. This script will allow the users to send prepared mail to the selected contacts once submitted. Please note that this is a free script to be used with our importers and it is not part of our importers therefore we will NOT provide support for this add-on.

Simple integration with POST method

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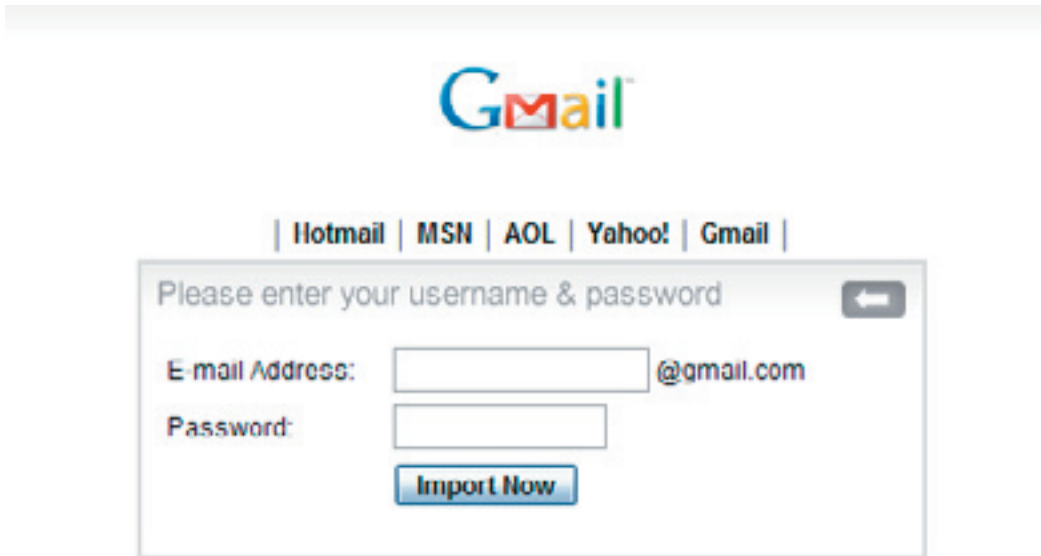
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Main interface

The following shows the main interface where the contacts will be both imported and displayed in a neat table. The file is named **index.php**. Please note that it is not compulsory to use our interfacing script to import the contacts.



Importing contacts using own scripting

You may import the script without using the default **index.php**. Please note that you will need to know your PHP programming well in order to do this part.

In the same directory, you will need to create a file with the following codes:

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Installation

You will need to follow the following steps before the importers will be able to work properly:

a. Create a directory if /tmp/ does not exist.

It is preferred that the path is NOT under the www or public_html. This is to avoid any potential security risk. Make sure the importers are allowed to create a file within the directory. Chmod has to be 0777.

b. Set the created cookie path in config.php

Under **config.php**, you set the cookie path for variable \$cookiepath. Make sure it has an ends slash.

c. Set POST action page

This will be the page where you want the selected emails array to be posted onto from **index.php**. If you want to send emails to the contacts, you may use the default **sendmail.php**.

Note: It is important that you contact our technician before five days after the purchase for free support and installation to avoid additional charges.

Troubleshooting

The followings are some known errors that will appear when certain conditions are met. Solutions are given:

Note: Make sure the cookie path is valid and has an ends slash. This is because the script will save it as <cookiepath/><cookie name>.xgc. Therefore, there must be a slash at the end.

Cannot find <cookiepath>. Please make sure it is valid!

Make sure the cookie path is set and exist on your server. You can check your server path through **phpinfo()** page. Contact us if you need more information regarding the cookie path.
